

Please call 860-572-2100 or email gellis@groton.k12.ct.us after November 1st to setup your registration appointment.

In order to ensure that your child is placed in the elementary school where they are districted to attend, or to participate in the magnet lotteries please register your child prior to April 15, 2019.

If your child is already enrolled in one of our Groton Public Schools elementary preschool programs and will be five years of age on or prior to January 1, 2020, it is not necessary to register the student for Kindergarten for the 2019-2020 school year.
