
A reminder that picture day is next Friday. Be sure your child is on time with their best smile.

In response to the concerns regarding Eastern Equine Encephalitis, I checked with Ledge Light Health District today and confirmed that we want to minimize outdoor activities from an hour before dusk to an hour after sunrise. I realize that many of our high school students and some of our middle school students are picked up by the school bus during the early morning hours when outdoor exposure should be minimized.

The health district recommended having students wear long pants and long sleeve shirts at early morning bus stops. In residential areas, the risk of exposure to mosquito bites is relatively low; however, in swampy areas, students should take more precautions.

I want to confirm these recommendations, and remind you to monitor the changing times of sunset and sunrise; we want to minimize outdoor activities an hour before sunset and the hour after sunrise.
