The APUSH Summer Assignment

Advanced Placement United States History is a challenging class introducing college-level concepts to highly motivated high school students. To help you prepare for the course, the Fitch High School Social Studies Department requires all enrolled students to complete a **required** summer assignment before the first day of class. All summer work is due, without exceptions, on the dues dates assigned during the course of the summer.

1) Part I - Reading and Notetaking (Recommended)

- **a**. <u>American Pageant Chapters 1 through 5</u> As you read Chapters 1 through 5, you should write pertinent information from each chapter. Any format of notetaking is permissible. In your wire-bound notebook of loose-leaf paper, you will take notes as you read the chapter. It is wise to take notes of keywords of people, places, events, and ideas. It is suggested that you include essential concepts, causes, and effects in your notes, comparing and contrasting events, etc. The rule of thumb, if it is significant, you should include the information in your notes.
- **b**. Important concepts for Units 1 and 2 will be posted in a hyperlink. The Key Concepts can be found in the following <u>DOCUMENT</u>, these important concepts should be used as a guide for your note-taking and understanding of the units. Reading the chapters and note-taking will help with the Vocabulary section of the summer assignment.

2) Part II - Vocabulary Terms and Definitions

- a. Unit 1 (1491-1607) and Unit 2 (1607-1754) Vocab List
- b. Click on the above link. You will read Chapter 1, Chapter 2, Chapter 3, Chapter 4 and Chapter 5 and define the following vocabulary terms. You will turn in your responses in typed form submitted into Schoology. Each response should be detailed, thorough, in proper context, and in complete sengtences. This assignment must be submitted through Schoology on August 1st. This assignment will count as a Quiz grade. Note: Ten points will be deducted each day your responses are not submitted to the teacher on the due date. A vocabulary Test will be given by the teacher at the beginning of the school year.
