This year, the Governor's Summer Reading Challenge theme is "Tails and Tales". To help students prioritize reading in their summer plans, we will be holding a Summer Reading Celebration in the fall. This summer we're asking students to -

- List titles of books they have read on the attached reading log
- Complete the Math Bingo Activities
- Turn in the Reading Log and Math Bingo sheets by Friday, September 17

Students will earn a **raffle ticket** for **each book** they read and math activity they complete. The more books they read, the more chances they have to win a prize at the Summer Reading Celebration.

We also would like to encourage you to check out the fun and exciting programs at Groton's public libraries (Groton Public Library, Mystic & Noank Library, and Bill Memorial Library) and the Subase NLON Library. Each of these libraries also offer access to their own digital services like ebooks, audiobooks, and Tumblebooks. Digital library cards are available too! All Groton students have access to ebooks through our reading app Sora. You can download the app or visit www.soraapp.com and log in with your Groton Google account to start checking out books! As a reminder, if you have a public library card you can link it to your Groton Sora to access the public library's digital collections too.
