 - viii. Early Concerns: possibly too many documentaries to view; still need to develop assessments

 - ii. Current enrollment is low (not able to recruit since building visits were nonexistent last year); goal is to increase enrollment
 - iii. Overall Program vision was also shared for Grades 6-12
 - iv. This is the formalization of existing curriculum in MYP format
