I. CALL TO ORDER – Chairperson Kim Shepardson Watson called the meeting to order at 6:04 p.m.

II. BOE REGULAR BUSINESS

MOTION: Ackerman, Porter: To approve the COW minutes of November 21, 2022

III. DISCUSSION WITH THE FIELDS COMMITTEE RE: FHS AS A PRIORITY (ATTACHMENT #1)

Mrs. Shepardson Watson gave an overview of the need for the Board to have this conversation with the Fields Committee on how the Board can partner with the Field Committee and asked where FHS is in their recommendations.

Mr. Norieka responded that the committee began by looking at the field shortages. They presented what their recommendation to the Board, Town Council, and RTM. However, the Mystic Oral School issue stagnated the process as well as Claude Chester School. Mr. Norieka noted that the package presented consisted of three parts, FHS, Sutton Park, and Claude Chester School, as the biggest areas to work on. He noted that there are 13 teams that leave the campus to go practice. The committee wanted to keep students on campus. Mr. Kosta noted support from state legislators, Senator Heather Somers, Representative Susan Conley, and Representative Aundre Bumgardner, to get State funding.

Mrs. Shepardson Watson stated that she believed that there would have to be a referendum for any of the three packages to move forward.

Mrs. Shepardson Watson noted that she would send an email to the Parks and Recreation Department stating that the Board has met with the Field Study Committee and asking Parks and Recreation to do a study of Sutton Park, FHS and Claude Chester School and asking the Town Council who starts the process for a referendum.

IV. ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE, & HIGH SCHOOLS' ENROLLMENT/CLASS SIZE
(ATTACHMENT #2a, b, c)

Superintendent Austin gave an overview of elementary, middle and high schools' enrollment and class sizes.

Board members noted areas of concern due to low enrollment.

V. UPDATE RE: IMPROVING PUBLIC SAFETY BY ENHANCING GROTON PUBLIC SCHOOL'S SECURITY SYSTEMS GRANT

Superintendent Austin, Mr. Kilpatrick, Dr. Kennedy gave an overview of the School Security Systems grant.

Superintendent Austin noted that they met with Town Manager John Burt, Chief Fascaro, and Chief Jenkins on the Mutualink software that would be used to link schools up with emergency services. She also noted that high end radios are being look at as well as other ways to connect with Town Bodies.

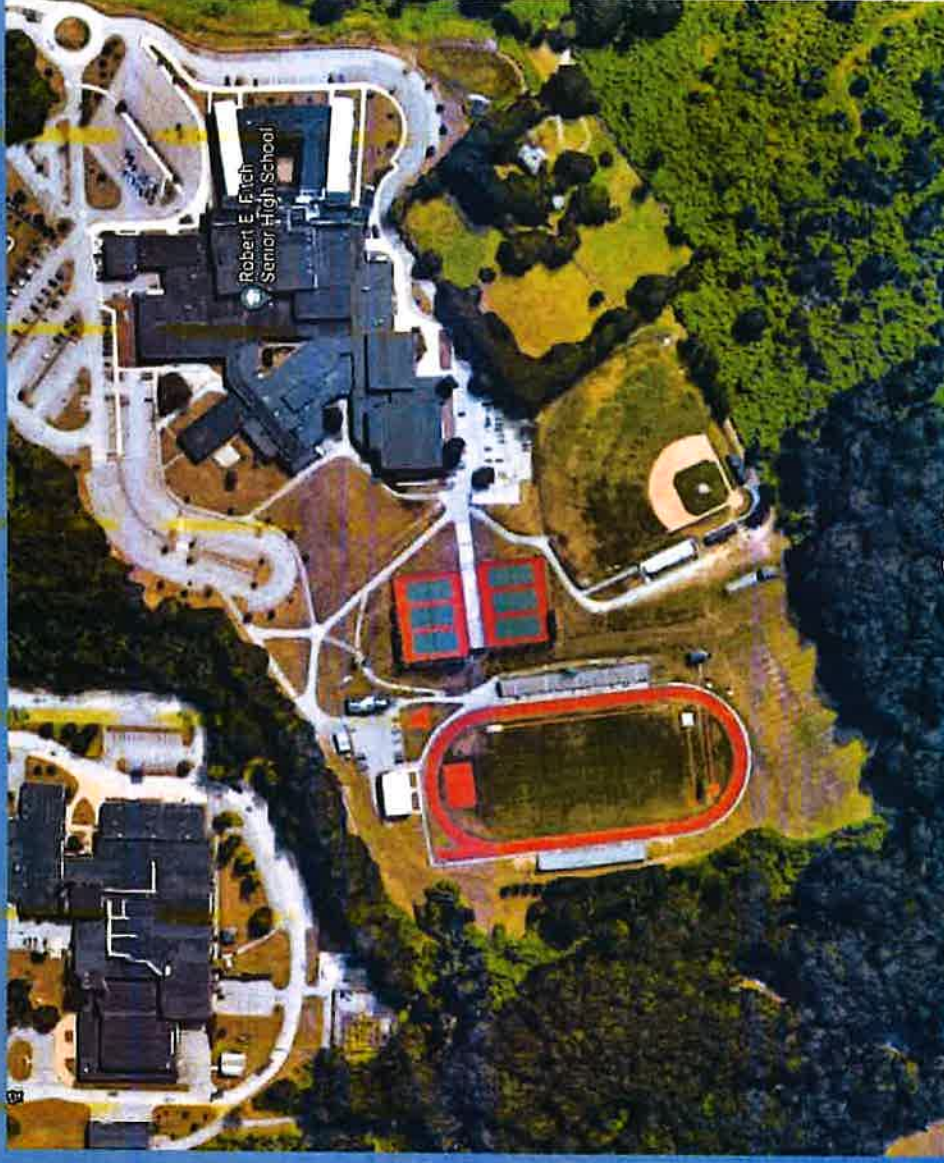
