Pick a square, do the activity, and record it in your passport!

You only need to record 5 activities but try to do them all!

Pick a board game and play. What math do you do while playing the game?	Make up your own math activity today and share it!	Record some number pairs that will together make 100!
With chalk, make a repeating pattern on a sidewalk or driveway near you!	Take out measuring cups and line them up! Which holds the most? Which holds the least?	Go on a shapes hunt for triangles and quadrilaterals. How are they similar? How are they different?
Start with 8 and count by 10's (8, 18, 28, ...). Try starting with a different number! Write your numbers in the sand or with paint. Talk to someone about the patterns you see.	Label each cup of an egg carton with the numbers 0-11. Put two coins in the carton, close the lid and shake it up. Open it up and add or subtract the two numbers that the coins landed in. Which is the sum? Which is the difference?	Coin swap! Gather coins from your piggy bank and from willing family members to sort and count. Try some trades! What can you "trade" a quarter for? How about a dime?
Think of things that come in 2's like a pair of socks! Skip count by 2's until you get to 40! Then try skip counting backwards from 40!	Pick up a potato or a can of soup. Try to find items that are lighter than the potato. Then try to find things that are heavier than your potato. Take a picture of your items.	Going to see a movie? How many people are going? If a ticket costs 5 dollars how much would it cost for three people to go?
