



Three Rivers Community College – Dual Enrollment College Career Pathways

Earn college credit by taking one or more of the following FHS classes

The College Career Pathways (CCP) program is a concurrent, or dual, enrollment program administered by Three Rivers Community College (TRCC). Students gain exposure to the academic challenges of college while in their familiar high school environment, earning college credit and a college transcript when they successfully complete the course. These college credits can be applied toward a program of study at Three Rivers Community College OR another college or university. Students must submit the online application and hard copy registration form by the deadline. Fitch High School students are given the opportunity to apply for the CCP course and credit at the start of the academic year. Our CCP instructors lead students through the application and registration process in class. If a student does not complete the web application **and** registration form by the deadline, they will not receive the Three Rivers Community College credit. If a student does not meet the pre-requisite grade and/or course, the instructor can grant their approval for the student to take the course for the CCP credit.
